From Incline Village: Take highway 28 to 50 to Carson City. At highway 395, South Carson turn left and continue to Fairview Drive. Turn right at Fairview and continue to freeway entrance north (entrance on right side). Travel 2 exits to College Parkway. Turn right on College Parkway. Go to the second street, Goni. Turn left at Goni and travel 2 blocks to Arrowhead Dr. .Turn right onto Arrowhead Dr. The Research Center is in the second block, right side.

From Reno: Take the freeway south to College Parkway exit at the north side of Carson City. Exit and turn left onto College Parkway and continue two streets to Goni. Turn left onto Goni and travel 2 blocks to Arrowhead Dr. Turn right onto Arrowhead Dr. The Research Center is in the second block, right side.
