<u>From North Lake Tahoe on Highway 267</u>: Travel on 267 then turn left onto Brockway Road. It is the first signal after the airport stop light. Get Ready! Now turn left immediately onto Hope Court. (That is where the railing stops on the left.) Follow Hope Court. It will curve right and at the fork go right onto Badger Lane to 10288 A (only building on the right). There is a bench and chandelier on the porch.

<u>From Highway 89</u>: Travel on Highway 89 and turn right onto West River Road and continue until stop sign by Jax Diner. Turn right, cross the river and continue through the roundabout. Just past the flashing yellow light turn right onto Hope Court. It will curve right and at the fork go right onto Badger Lane to 10288 A (only building on the right). There is a bench and chandelier on the porch.
